Early childhood screening:
as easy as 1, 2, 3 . . . and free!

Three reasons to screen at age 3*:

- 1 Early screening can mean the difference between success and failure in school.
- 2 Any health or learning concerns can be found earlier — and help provided sooner.
- 3 Because screening is free, it's easy and it's good for your child!

**Screening is preferred at three, but can be done at four or five.*

When your child is 3 years old:

- 1 Call 348-TOTS to set an appointment
- 2 Complete the health forms they will send you
- 3 Bring your child to the screening appointment, where school nurses will check your child's:
 - vision and hearing
 - growth and development
 - immunizations and family history

Early childhood screening helps:

- 1 You find out how your child is doing
- 2 Connect you with early childhood programs
- 3 Answer your parenting questions

Call immediately if you are concerned about your child's development — screens can be done anytime before age three.



State law requires all children to be screened before entering kindergarten.
